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
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Übung 4 (Besprechung 09.11.2017)

- (1) Bestimmen Sie für die folgenden Beispiele, ob es sich um Subject/Object-Raising- oder Subject/Object-Control-Konstruktionen handelt. Geben Sie für die o.g. Sätze jeweils einen Prädikatenlogikausdruck an, der der Argumentstruktur des jeweiligen Satzes entspricht.
- John appears to know Paul.
Subject Raising; *appear(know(John, Paul))*
 - Susan believed John to be honest.
Object Raising: *believe(Susan, honest(John))*
 - John allowed the kids to play in the autumn leaves.
Object Control: *allow(John, kids, play – in – the – leaves(kids))*
 - Susan refused to go to bed.
Subject Control: *refuse(Susan, go – to – bed(Susan))*
 - Tom asked Paul to open the window.
Object Control: *ask(Tom, Paul, open – the – window(Paul))*
 - Tom continued to write the text.
Subject Raising: *continue(write – the – text(Tom))*
- Raising:
 - Subject to subject: the **subject** of the infinitival complement is raised to **subject** position of the matrix clause (see (1-a)).
 - Subject to object: the **subject** of the infinitival complement is raised to **object** position of the matrix clause (see (1-b)).
 - Control:
 - Subject control: the subject of the matrix verb is also the subject of the infinitival verb (see (1-d)).
 - Object control: the object of the matrix verb is also the object of the infinitival verb (see (1-e)).

(2) Geben Sie FTAG-Analysen für die Sätze (1-e) und (1-f) an.

a. Tom asked Paul to open the window.



- b. Tom continued to write the text.
