Exercise 1 (20.11.2015) Classify the following examples as to whether they are cases of object/subject control or object/subject raising.

- (1) John expects Mary to come.
- (2) His brother implores him to come.
- (3) They seem to be happy.
- (4) They promise them to come.
- (5) John wants him to win the race.
- (6) John believes him to be a nice guy.
- (7) The children hope to be successful.
